Setting up for Dental Implant Surgery

An Interactive Workshop for Dental Staff working with Dental Implants

Advice on where to obtain the important materials required for the surgery will be provided during the course. Understand the role of the 'floating nurse', implant ordering, presurgical planning and much more. The workshop will include a power point presentation, step-by step visual instruction on the set-up of the dental surgery. There will be plenty of time for interaction and questions though the course.
